Superintendent of Police Warren J. Riley today stated that relative to inquiries about an article that appeared in the Nation Journal on December 17, 2008, The New Orleans Police Department did not receive any complaints or information to substantiate any of the allegations of racial conflicts or vigilante type crimes in the City of New Orleans including the Algiers Point on the west bank of the City. Superintendent Riley further stated that he is currently looking into the allegations, and asked if anyone has creditable information relative to any incidents of this type to call the New Orleans Police Department Bureau of Investigations 658-5300, Assistant Superintendent Marlon Defillo or Lieutenant Fred Austin.
